7:15AM -8:30 AM	Practice and run through on the field (park by the office or cafeteria <u>not</u> the band room)
8:30 AM -9:45 AM	Load equipment first and then grab a snack on your own!
9:45 AM	BUS ARRIVES @ CHS – Student seated for attendance behind the clock before loading.
10:15 AM	Bus Departs- for Royal High in Simi Valley
11:45 PM	Lunch at Castaic McDonald's [intersection of Lake Hughes and Castaic Rd] <i>(Bring Money or a sack lunch)</i>
1:00 PM	Bus Departs from Lunch
2:00 PM	Arrive at Royal High School (1402 Royal Ave, Simi Valley, CA 93065) Stretch as a group/Use Restrooms
2:15 PM	Get Dressed
3:00 PM	Warm Up Time (Area A)
3:45 PM	Leave Warm Up
3:55 PM	At Field
4:00 PM	Perform
5:00 PM	Return to parking lot change and clean up
5:20 PM	Return to stadium promptly. We will arrive during the dinner break. Dinner will be in the Stadium during intermissions (bring money or a sack dinner and sit in our section)
9:00 PM	Awards
9:45PM	BUS DEPARTS (Use Restroom First)
11:55PM	Arrive @ CHS; unload and clean up
Approx 12:15 AM	Go home AFTER all clean-up is finished. (Parents who do not travel with us are still welcome to help with the loading in the morning and the clean-up process afterward. Note: Students <u>will not</u> be dismissed until everything is unloaded, cleaned and organized regardless of the hour so please lend a hand.)

MARCHING BAND COMPETITION INFORMATION

- Students will not be allowed to travel without a signed permission slip including the medical release and contact information.
- Bring money or a sack lunch for all meals on the schedule. Concessions at competitions usually cost \$8-10 per meal. Generally we will also be stopping for Fast Food. \$20 is typically recommended but keep your student's appetite in mind when determining if they need more. Again sack meals are acceptable too.
- No food is to be eaten on the bus, unless otherwise specified— only food in tightly sealed containers may be transported.
- Seating on the bus will be separated by gender – no couples seated together.
- You will be assigned a bus to ride and you may not switch to be with your friends, you WILL get caught.
- All students will travel in their show shirts and should have layers of clothing in school colors. The days are long and the weather may change significantly (warm ups preferred).
- Again Dress in layers! Be prepared for warm and cold weather while we sit in the stadium watching performances.
- Students must stay with a group of four or more at all times (at rest stops and at the competition).
- Be on your best behavior at all times – we are representing our school and our community.
- With advanced notice, parent chaperones are welcome to ride our buses; there are typically about 6 seats available
- If a parent needs to pick up a student at the competition, they should write a note Mr. Ouska in advance, and they will need to sign the student out in person at the event.
- When we arrive back at the school students will be assigned a job to clean up regardless of the time of arrival.
- Parents who don't attend the competition are invited to help out with cleaning when we get back to make the process go faster.
- Spectator tickets (for parents etc.) prices vary but are typically \$6-12 each.
